



Apprenticeship Standards

During your on programme learning, you will develop your skills, knowledge and behaviour relating to your chosen Apprenticeship Standard.

You will achieve Functional Skills English and maths, up to and including level 2, unless you hold suitable prior achievements.

Also, there may be an opportunity to achieve an accredited Certificate / Diploma.

Throughout your Apprenticeship, you must evidence a minimum of 20% off-the-job learning during your contracted working hours.

Once you have completed your on programme learning, you will prepare for End Point Assessment.

End Point Assessment is managed by an external organisation and will be completed either face to face or remote using suitable technology e.g. Skype. You will be assessed using a range of methods.

Dependent upon your chosen
Standard, you could achieve a Pass,
Merit or Distinction overall grade.
